THE ABOMINABLE SNOWMEN — Episode 2, first shown 7 October 1967

Arriving in Tibet, the Doctor plans to return a holy relic which a monastery entrusted to him for safe keeping. But he finds the once-friendly monks hostile and suspicious, now that the gentle Yeti of the Himalayas have become savage killers...

THE ENEMY OF THE WORLD — Episode 3, first shown 6 January 1968

The Doctor has a double: Salamander, inventor of the 'sun-stone', who has saved the world from starvation. Giles Kent, once Salamander's ally, suspects his real aim is to seize power. The Doctor falls in with Kent, while Jamie and Victoria are given jobs in Salamander's retinue. After a volcanic eruption in Hungary, political leader Denies accuses Salamander of creating the disaster himself, but Salamander responds by having him deposed and arrested.

THE WEB OF FEAR — Episode 1, first shown 3 February 1968

Salamander has attempted to steal the TARDIS but is sucked out into the vortex. Will the Doctor and his friends share his fate? And what horror awaits them in the London Underground?

THE WHEEL IN SPACE — Episode 3, first shown 11 May 1968

The TARDIS has materialized inside an abandoned rocket drifting in space. The Doctor and Jamie are taken to a nearby space station, and its Controller orders the rocket destroyed by the Wheel's laser gun—with the TARDIS still on board! There is another alien presence on the rocket, too: strange eggs which begin to hatch out... to what?

THE WHEEL IN SPACE — Episode 6, first shown 1 June 1968

The Cybermen have penetrated the Wheel, taken over some of its crew, and now plan to poison its air supply. Jamie and Zoe are spacewalking across to the rocket to fetch a vital component from the TARDIS, when the Wheel is attacked by a meteorite storm!

THE SPACE PIRATES — Episode 2, first shown 15 March 1969

The TARDIS materializes on a space beacon, and the Doctor and his friends find themselves in the middle of an attack by space pirates. Trapped inside one section with the lock fused, the travelers are blown to the floor as the pirates detonate their explosives...

DISC ONE

THE LION — Episode 1 of *The Crusade*, first shown 27 March 1965
The TARDIS lands in a wood in Palestine, where a king is ambushed, and Barbara is taken prisoner by the Saracens.

THE WHEEL OF FORTUNE — Episode 3 of *The Crusade*, first shown 10 April 1965
King Richard has knighted Ian and sent him as an emissary to Saladin. Barbara has been kidnapped by El Akir's men, but slips her captors in the streets of Lydda.

DAY OF ARMAGEDDON — Episode 2 of *The Daleks' Master Plan*, first shown 20 November 1965
On the planet Kembel in the year 4000, the Doctor and his companions encounter Space Special Security agent Bret Vyon. The Daleks too are on Kembel, assembling a grand alliance to conquer the galaxy.

COUNTER PLOT — Episode 5 of *The Daleks' Master Plan*, first shown 11 December 1965
The Doctor and his companions have followed Mavic Chen to Earth, but Katarina is killed en route. Chen sends agent Sara Kingdom to assassinate them; Bret is the first to die...

ESCAPE SWITCH — Episode 10 of *The Daleks' Master Plan*, first shown 15 January 1966
The Doctor has stolen the core of the time destructor and fled in the TARDIS, but the Daleks pursue him through time. The TARDIS arrives in ancient Egypt, where the Great Pyramid is being built; but the Daleks are not the only old enemy looking for revenge on the Doctor...

THE FINAL TEST — Episode 4 of *The Celestial Toymaker*, first shown 23 April 1966
Trapped in the domain of the Celestial Toymaker, the Doctor is made invisible and forced to play a game of intellect. His companions too must play the Toymaker's games; if they win, they will regain the TARDIS and may go free; but if they lose, they will become his playthings forever...

Professor Zaroff has promised to raise the lost city of Atlantis from beneath the sea, but the Doctor discovers his true intention: to destroy the world!

THE MOONBASE — Episode 2, first shown 18 February 1967
Plague has struck a weather control base on the Moon in the year 2070, and the bodies of the victims are vanishing from the sick bay. Jamie has been injured during a low-gravity moonwalk, and believes in his delirium that the Phantom Piper of the McCrimmons has come for him

THE MOONBASE — Episode 4, first shown 4 March 1967
The Cybermen have been expelled from the base, but regroup on the lunar surface, ready to move in for their final attack...

THE FACELESS ONES — Episode 1, first shown 8 April 1967
Gatwick Airport - and the TARDIS lands in the path of an incoming jet!

THE FACELESS ONES — Episode 3, first shown 22 April 1967
Jamie has met Samantha Briggs, whose brother disappeared on a Chameleon Tours package holiday. Investigating the office in the Chameleon hangar, the Doctor walks into a trap...

THE EVIL OF THE DALEKS — Episode 2, first shown 27 May 1967
The TARDIS has been stolen! The Doctor and Jamie follow a trail to a London antique shop selling genuine Victoriana, but Kennedy, the man they are looking for, has troubles of his own...
